ADVERTISEMENT / INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Plattekill, hereinafter called the Owner, is soliciting bids from qualified contractors for the replacement of the culvert that conveys the Quassaic Creek under Old Unionville Road. The work shall generally include the execution of improvement work necessary to provide for dewatering and erosion control, removal of the existing culvert (and concrete invert), installation of a temporary culvert, the installation of the new culvert with headwalls/wingwalls, installation of guide rail, backfill and compaction to prep for paving and complete site restoration.

Receipt of Bids: Separate sealed bids will be received by the Owner until 1 p.m. (local time) on Monday, August 4th, 2014. All bids must be made upon and in accordance with the form of proposals included in the bid package, and shall be submitted in sealed envelopes so marked "Old Unionville Culvert Replacement". Bids will be opened and publicly read at Town Hall, 1915 Route 44-55, Modena, NY, 12548.

It is strongly recommended that Bidders attend a Pre-Bid Meeting at the Community Center, located at the Plattekill Community Center, 2047 State Route 32, Modena, New York, at 2 pm on Wednesday, July 23rd, 2014. Representatives of the Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project.

Beginning on Wednesday, July 9th, 2014, the Bidding Documents may be picked up at the Town Clerk's Office for a non refundable fee of \$25.00.

Bids will be considered immediately. If award is to proceed to the Successful Bidder, it will be dated within 21 days of the Bid deadline. This will mark the beginning of the Contract Time. Barring unforeseen inclement weather conditions the work is to be completed by Friday, October 31st, 2014. Contractors shall include a proposed schedule of work with their bids, and shall be able to demonstrate their qualifications, specifically with the installation of dewatering systems and large culverts, with references.

OWNER'S RIGHTS RESERVED: The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formality or technicality in any Bid in the interest of the Owner.

STATEMENT OF NON-COLLUSION: Bidders are required to execute the non-collusion bidding certificate presented within the Bid Package, pursuant to Section 103 of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

Bidders are also required to comply with the provision of Section 291-299 of the Executive Law of the State of New York.

The Owner hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in regard to any Contract entered into pursuant to this invitation, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for any award.

Prevailing Wage Rates in the State of New York apply to this Contract – the Prevailing Wage Case Number for the project is PRC# 2014004521. A schedule will be forwarded to the successful bidder immediately upon receipt of Notice of Award.
