DEPARTMENT OF STATE SMART GROWTH COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING AND ZONING
PROGRAM (ZONING CODE UPDATE)

Supervisor Depew made a motion to adopt the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town of Plattekill is applying for the Smart Growth Planning and Zoning Program Administered by the NY Department of State for a project entitled “Plattekill Zoning Code Update” to be located in the Town of Plattekill;

WHEREAS, the applicant municipality may obtain the approval/endorsement of the governing body of the municipality or municipalities in which the project will be located;

WHEREAS, the Department of State, pursuant to the Smart Growth Zoning Grant regulations requires an applicant to fund up to 10% of the total project cost, pursuant to the grant program;

WHEREAS, the Town has secured up to 10% (\$7,500) of the total project cost, pursuant to the grant program, in cash and in kind services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing board of the Town of Plattekill hereby does approve and endorse the application for a grant under the Smart Growth Planning and Zoning Program Administered by the NY Department of State e, for a project known as the “Plattekill Zoning Code Update” and located within this community.

RESOLUTION 36 OF 2025

Expressing Support for the Ulster County Legislature's Adoption of Resolution No. 102 - Establishing A Policy to Fund, Facilitate, Perpetuate and Support the Augmentation and Operation of Local Emergency Medical Services (EMS) In and For the County of Ulster

Date: March 19, 2025

WHEREAS, the provision of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) is essential to ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of the residents of the Town of Shawangunk and Ulster County as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Plattekill, along with other municipalities in Ulster County, faces increasing operational costs in maintaining reliable EMS services, including personnel, training, equipment, and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the recently released EMS Services Delivery Report for Ulster County, New York, prepared by the Center for Public Safety Management, LLC, has identified significant challenges, including staffing shortages, increasing response times, and financial instability among local EMS providers; and

WHEREAS, proposed Resolution No. 102 establishes a policy to fund, facilitate, perpetuate, and support the augmentation and operation of local EMS in an amount not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) per annum, thereby providing much-needed financial relief and stability to municipal EMS services; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 102 further mandates transparency and accountability by requiring that funds be used solely for EMS-related expenses, including staffing, training, equipment procurement, and operational costs, with annual reporting requirements to the Ulster County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Plattekill recognizes that the sustainability and enhancement of EMS services are critical to public health and safety and that Resolution No. 102 represents a proactive and fiscally responsible approach to addressing EMS challenges in Ulster County

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Plattekill hereby expresses its strong support for the Ulster County Legislature's adoption of Resolution No. 102 and urges its full implementation to ensure the continued availability of high-quality EMS services for all residents of Ulster County; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Ulster County Legislature, the Ulster County Executive, the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services, and any other relevant agencies as an expression of the Town of Plattekill's support for sustained EMS funding and service enhancement within the County.
